- Jo’s Hot Coffee holds a sweet corner spot in the heart of SoCo with its spray painted words "I love you so much." In 2010, local musician Amy Cook scripted the simple love letter to her partner Liz Lambert, majority owner at Jo’s. An immediate influx of people sought out the wall, taking photos with friends and lovers. The site quickly went viral.
- In 1945 the population of Austin was 100,000. Currently the population of Austin is 964,000, and the population of Greater Austin is 2,228,000.

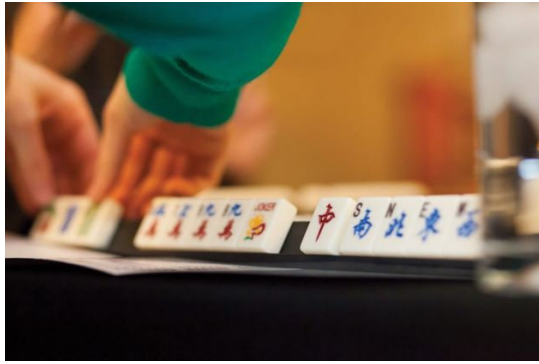

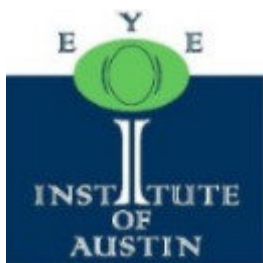
