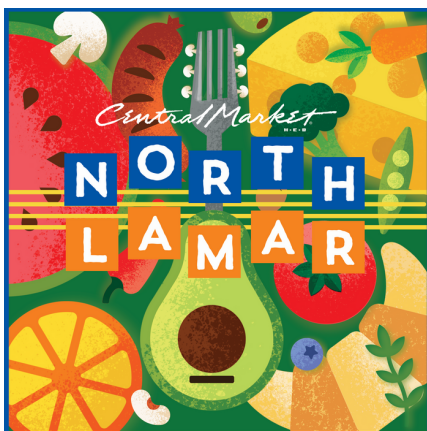
Linda died from complications due to Alzheimer's at the age of 78.
